

## **Notice: CM/ECF Information**

The First Circuit has implemented the Case Management portion of the Federal Judiciary's Case Management-Electronic Case Files ("CM/ECF") computer system. As of March 31, 2008, any new court-generated document (e.g., orders, opinions, and judgments) will be attached as a hyperlink to the docket.

Beginning August 27, 2008, parties may receive electronic notice of docket entries and court-generated documents from the court through Notices of Docket Activity ("NDAs"). Attorneys and pro se litigants in **pending** cases may register to participate in electronic noticing at [http://pacer.psc.uscourts.gov/announcements/general/ea\\_filer.html](http://pacer.psc.uscourts.gov/announcements/general/ea_filer.html).

The court has not yet put into place that part of CM/ECF which allows parties to file documents electronically. However, as an interim step, the court has begun posting public briefs and petitions for rehearing/rehearing en banc. The court may also scan and attach other filings.

Electronic case filing will be available in the future. Litigants should check this website periodically to keep up-to-date.
