

CM/ECF Information

The First Circuit has implemented the Case Management portion of the Federal Judiciary's Case Management-Electronic Case Files ("CM/ECF") computer system. As of March 31, 2008, any new court-generated document (e.g., notices, orders, opinions, and judgments) will be attached as a hyperlink to the docket.

Beginning August 27, 2008, parties may receive electronic notice of docket entries and court-generated documents from the court through Notices of Docket Activity ("NDAs"). Attorneys and pro se litigants in **pending** cases may register to participate in electronic noticing at http://pacer.psc.uscourts.gov/announcements/general/ea_filer.html.

The court has not yet put into place that part of CM/ECF which allows parties to file documents electronically, and, therefore, those filings will not appear on the docket (except in the rare case where the court has scanned and attached the document). Electronic case filing will be available in the future.

Litigants should check this website periodically to keep up-to-date.
