Chief Judge Barron concluded the above-captioned complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(2) and the Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings (Rules of Judicial-Conduct), Rule 11(e). Pursuant to Rule 11(g)(3) of the Rules of Judicial-Conduct, the order concluding the complaint, the order identifying the complaint under Rule 5(a) of the Rules of Judicial-Conduct, "all materials obtained in connection with the [limited] inquiry [conducted] under Rule 11(b) [of the Rules of Judicial-Conduct]," and the subject judge's written submission regarding the order concluding the complaint were transmitted to a review panel of the Judicial Council of the First Circuit.
