Cakes normally combine some kind of flour, a sweetening agent (commonly sugar), a binding agent (generally egg, though gluten or starch are often used by vegetarians and vegans), fats (usually butter, shortening, or margarine, although a fruit **purée (/define.php?term=pur%C3%A9e)** such as applesauce is sometimes substituted to avoid using fat), a liquid (milk, water or fruit juice), flavors and some form of **leavening (/define.php?term=leavening)** agent (such as yeast or baking powder), though many cakes lack these ingredients and instead rely on air bubbles in the dough to expand and cause the cake to rise. Cake is often frosted with **buttercream (/define.php?term=buttercream)** or marzipan, and finished with piped borders and **crystallized (/define.php?term=crystallized)** fruit.<sup>1</sup>

Cake is often the dessert of choice for meals at ceremonial occasions, particularly weddings, anniversaries and birthdays. There are literally millions of cake recipes (some are bread-like and some rich and elaborate) and many are centuries old. Cake making is no longer a complicated procedure; while at one time considerable labor went into cake making (particularly the **whisking (/define.php?term=whisking)** of egg **foams (/define.php?term=foams)**), baking equipment and directions have been simplified that even the most amateur cook may **bake a cake (/define.php?term=bake%20a%20cake)**.

SomeGuy1: It really is pathetic that you would make accusations about my sexuality instead of coming up with a legitimate argument. I wonder if you even watched the video before posting.

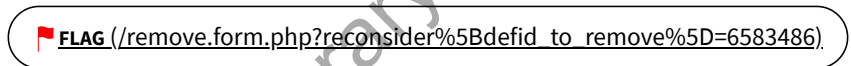
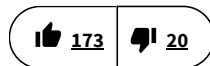

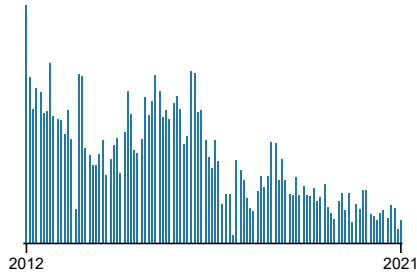
