



## cashier's check

Check written by a bank (or other financial institution) on its own funds, and signed by the bank's cashier or other such officer.

Cashier's check is used mainly for disbursing proceeds of a loan to a customer, or to a third-party named by the customer. In contrast, a certified check is drawn on the customer's funds. Also called official check, manager's check, or treasurer's check.

Use cashier's check in a sentence

- Usually if you apply for a loan they won't just give you cash they will likely pay you out with a cashier's check.
